

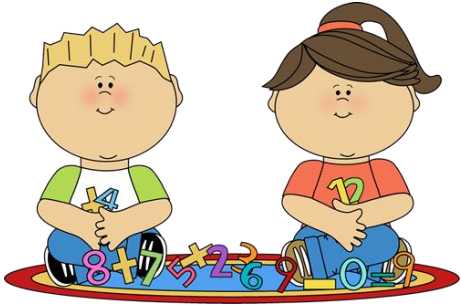

## Full-Day Pre-Kindergarten Program

- HOURS: Monday – Friday; 8:00AM – 2:30PM (full days) ; 8:00AM – 11:30AM (half days)
- After School Care available until 6:00PM on full days and 3:00PM on half days for an additional fee
- Pre-Kindergarten student must SUBMIT IMMUNIZATION RECORDS and A birth certificate or passport
- Pre-K 1 (3 year old program) – child must be 3 by December 1<sup>st</sup>
- Pre-K 2 (4 year old program) – child must be 4 by December 1<sup>st</sup>

#### 2017 – 2018 FEES:

Tuition	\$7,600 (paid August 2017 through May 2018)
Registration Fee	\$125 (new students) ; \$100 (returning students) - paid at time of registration
Consumable Fee	\$190 (paid in July 2017)
SMART Tuition	\$40 (paid in July 2017)
Parents' Club Dues	\$40 (paid in July 2017)

#### FULL-DAY PRE-K 3 YEAR OLD PROGRAM (PK1)

This program introduces children to a new school environment. Children will learn the fundamentals needed for them to succeed in a classroom setting, such as, proper hygiene behaviors, personal care, social skills and motor development. We follow the EngageNY and Archdiocesan Curriculum:

- ELA – letter & letter recognition
- MATH – numbers 1 through 10 and basic shapes
- SCIENCE and SOCIAL STUDIES – the life cycle, weather, community helpers and more.

By June, children will have learned the fundamentals required to join our Pre-K 4's Program.

#### FULL-DAY PRE-K 4 YEAR OLD PROGRAM (PK2)

This program is a continuation of the Pre-K 1 program and the children will apply the skills learned in the previous year. The Pre-K 2 program also follows the EngageNY and Archdiocesan Curriculum.

- ELA – reintroduction to letters and letter recognition; letter sounds and building of two-three letter words
- MATH – count and recognize numbers 1-20, patterns and time
- SCIENCE and SOCIAL STUDIES – continue study about life cycle, weather, community helpers and more

By June, children will have learned the fundamentals required for them to enter Kindergarten.
